## How to recycle / dispose of use and empty Gas Cartridges

Most local authorities now except empty disposable Gas Cartridges as well as Aerosols in household recycling bins. Please check with your local authority if you are unsure.

The general advice on Aerosols is as follows;

General aerosols including disposable Gas Cartridges can be recycled in the household recycling bin.

Aerosols with orange hazard symbols (e.g. insecticides, oven cleaners, paints and automotive sprays) are not accepted in the recycling bin, these should be put in the general waste bin.

Due to health and safety reasons they must be empty, please remove loose plastic lids and place in your general waste bin. Do not pierce or squash them. Under no circumstances should Gas Cartridges or Aerosols be thrown onto fires.

Before recycling large qualities, contact your local authority.
